

NANTES: INTERNATIONAL CONVENTION CENTRE



With 20% of the international audience and 100 nationalities welcomed in 2006, Nantes has confirmed its international attraction. Jacques Tallut, General Director of the Nantes International Convention Centre stresses that: 'Nantes is a major city in Western Europe and the area is first-ranked in terms of economy, culture and tourism.'
